Schedule of Races

- One race is scheduled

Warning Signal

- The first warning signal will be made at 1200 hours.

Starting Line

- The starting line will be between an orange flag displayed on the RC boat and ALLERTON BELL G "3" MBSA List C, Mark 13, or another suitable mark determined by the Race Committee.

Course

- Will be displayed on the Race Committee Boat prior to the Start using MBSA Standard Rounding Marks Lists A and C.

Time Limit

- Five hours after the start of each class.

Entries

Eligibility

- Open to PHRF boats with valid PHRFNE handicap certificates.

Fees

- \$35.00 – MBSA or USSA members
- \$40.00 – all other entries
- The Hitchcock Trophy is part of the HBPHRF Season's Pass.

Additional Sailing Instructions

Rules

- This event will be governed by the Mass Bay Sailing Association General Sailing Instructions except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions.

Classes

- This race will be scored using valid PHRF ratings and a Time-on-Time scoring with a correction factor of 550.
- Classes will be in accordance with to MBSA class splits.

Flags

- Yachts shall fly their class flag from the backstay.

Race Announcements

- The Race Committee will use VHF Channel 71 for all Recalls
- Yachts must notify the RC if withdrawing.

Signals Made Ashore

- Will be displayed on the flagpole on the North Deck of the Hingham Yacht Club, and announced on VHF Channel 71.

Notices to Competitors

- Will be posted on the official notice board located outside the main clubhouse at the Hingham Yacht Club on the Race Committee bulletin board.

Protests

- All boats intending to file a protest must complete a written protest on a US Sailing Protest Form (downloadable from www.hbphrf.org). The form should be scanned and emailed to the Hingham Bay fleet governor (hbphrf@gmail.com) within 24 hours of the incident.

Post-Race Awards and Social Activities

Awards will be presented at the Cookout at Hingham Yacht Club. The Overall Winner will receive the Ethan W. Hitchcock Trophy. Awards will also be presented for First, Second, and Third place finishers in each fleet. Free moorings will be available to visiting boats.
